

MAG-300 Chipper Blade Vice INSTRUCTIONS

The MAG-300 quickly and safely holds chipper blades so they may easily be sharpened with a MAG-8000 or MAG-9000 Lawnmower Blade Sharpener.

- 1. Ensure leading edge of the chipper blade is relatively square when sharpening is finished
- 2. To balance the blades, weigh each blade individually.
- 3. Blades mounted on the same chipper drum should be the same weight approximately within a half ounce. Check the chipper manufacturer's recommendations.

OPERATION OF THE MAG-300

- 1. Place the chipper blade on a flat surface.
- 2. Pull the ring, to release the pin to open the jaw.
- 3. Place the MAG-300 over the blade
- 4. Pull the ring, to release the pin to close the jaw.
- 5. Lock the pin in a hole as close to the blade as possible.
- 6. Rotate the handle of the MAG-300 to tighten the inner vice jaw.
- 7. Now the blade is held tightly in the vice ready to be sharpened.

WEAR GLOVES, BEWARE OF SHARP EDGES WHEN HANDLING BLADES
